

Ideas to help a project.

You can choose a project you care about then work to make a difference.

1 } Teamwork

- Make the project a family goal. Ask your parents if your family can help.
- Ask your teacher if the project can be a class effort.
- Suggest the project to your Sunday School Class, VBS, Bible Study Group or AWANA.

2 } Prayer

- Commit to pray regularly for the project.
- Make a prayer reminder to put in your Bible or to set on your family dinner table.
- Create prayer reminders or small posters for others to use.

3 } Giving

- Set a giving goal.
- Be creative. Think of ideas like bake sales or giving drives to raise funds for the project.
- Have one adult be responsible for collecting the money and giving it to the project.
- For a church, school or other group project, consider making a classroom poster as a reminder.

4 } Helping

- Some projects are too far away and too difficult to visit. Giving and prayer may be a great contribution to those needs.
- If you can visit the project, do it! It will encourage those working on the project and those who benefit from it. It will also encourage you.
- Find out if the project has something you can do. Don't assume what they need.
